

ROCKY HORROR PROP LIST



Bubbles: At the beginning of the film is the wedding of Ralph Hapschatt and Betty Munroe. As the newlyweds exit the church, you should blow bubbles when the on-screen wedding guests throw the rice. You can also blow bubbles later in the film as Frank takes Rocky to the honeymoon suite. (No Rice)



Newspapers: When Brad and Janet are caught in the storm, Janet covers her head with a newspaper The "Plain Dealer". At this point, you should likewise cover your head.



Small Spray Bottle (Water only): These are used by members of the audience to simulate the rainstorm that Brad and Janet are caught in. (Now do you see why you should use the newspapers?) Do NOT squirt water at other audience members, the screen or the performers as this may cause damage to the auditorium or costumes. (NO WATER GUNS!)



Glow stick, flashlight, digital lighter (on your phone): During the "There's a light" verse of "Over at the Frankenstein Place," you should light up the theater with glow sticks, flashlights, digital lighters, etc. (NO OPEN FLAMES!)



Rubber gloves: During and after the creation speech, Frank snaps his rubber gloves three times. Later, Magenta pulls these gloves off his hands. You should snap your gloves in sync each time to create a fantastic sound effect.



Noisemakers: At the end of the creation speech, the Transylvanians respond with applause and noisemakers. You should do the same.



Confetti: At the end of the "Charles Atlas Song" reprise, the Transylvanians throw confetti as Rocky and Frank head toward the bedroom. You could also blow bubbles again.



Toilet paper: When Dr. Scott enters the lab, Brad cries out "Great Scott!" At this point, you should hurl rolls of toilet paper into the air (preferably Scotts).



Fake Toast: When Frank proposes a toast at dinner, members of the audience throw plastic, cardboard or foam toast into the air. (Don't throw real food please)



Party hat(s): At the dinner table, when Frank puts on a party hat, you should do the same. Be creative with the quantity and placement of your hat(s)!



Bell or Keys: During the song "Planet Schmanet Janet," ring the bell when Frank sings "Did you hear a bell ring?"



Cards: During the song "I'm Going Home," Frank sings "Cards for sorrow, cards for pain". At this point you should shower the theater with cards.

Cards are slippery on carpet; try not to throw them into the aisles, or at the screen

To protect the participants and venue please throw UP and BACK (unless you are in the back row)
